

-SUMMER INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITIES-

Interested in completing a summer internship with brainLENS?

brainLENS (Hoeft Laboratory for Educational NeuroScience, brainLENS.org) at UCSF combines cutting edge, interdisciplinary research methods with a deep passion for maximizing children's potential in life. UCSF is a premier biomedical research institution, ranked within the top 5 in the world for Neuroscience and Behavior by US News.

We currently have opportunities for two types of summer internships.

Neuroscience Exploration Week (1 week): Neuroscience Exploration Week is an experience that exposes participants to research and the fields of neuroscience, education, psychology, and medicine. Students will observe neuroimaging scans, learn how to conduct neuropsychological assessments, participate in discussions and seminars, rotate through different laboratories, and much more. The week culminates in a project where students present their own neuroimaging analyses.

Full Summer Internship (8 week; includes Neuroscience Exploration Week): The full time summer internship typically consists of students focusing on a particular project, and contributing to literature reviews, data coding/cleaning/entry, and recruitment or outreach events related to that project. In the past, students have also authored poster presentations and scientific articles. Students are expected to come into the laboratory 5 days a week for at least 8 weeks.
